

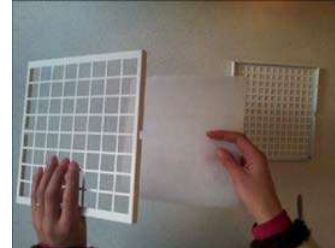
Changing the Kitchen Extract Filter.

1. Remove the centre section of the grill by pushing the central cassette up and sliding it to one side slightly. **Picture A**

Note: if the grill is surface mounted as opposed to flush mounted then you may have to remove a clear plastic bung on the side of the grill frame before removing the central cassette.

2. Split the filter assembly by pulling the two halves apart. There is a slot in the side of the frame in which either a flat screwdriver or the handle of a spoon can be used to prise the two halves apart. **Picture B**
3. Remove the fleece filter and replace it. **Picture C**
4. Re-install the filter by reversing the instructions above.
